PREMISES LICENSING AGREEMENT

Notice to hirers of the requirements they must comply with in respect of their use of the Church Hall / Church.

Permitted days and hours of use: as agreed.

Numbers limited to: 60 in the Chapel / Church each, subject to HM Government legislation, orders and guidance, etc for example in respect of the Covid-19 pandemic for which each group must have conducted a detailed risk assessment and prepared a thorough plan for the safe operation of the premises during their use thereof.

Organisers of events are also responsible for:

Ensuring that the NO SMOKING requirement is observed.

Excluding the use of special effects or naked flames.

Keeping FIRE EXITS free of all obstruction and easily usable.

Unlocking FIRE EXITS and making sure those present are aware of their location.

Allowing ADEQUATE SPACE BETWEEN TABLES to ensure free movement at all times.

Arranging that where any persons in wheelchairs are attending, there is someone responsible for their safe evacuation in case of fire.

Seeing that the level of noise emanating from the premises is such as not to cause annoyance to neighbours.

Indemnity

In booking the premises, those doing so understand that they agree to indemnify the trustees of the Church / Chapel against any claims for damages against them which might arise from their / their groups use of the premises; and that they further indemnify the trustees against damage or loss to their property arising from any negligence on their part or that of their invitees.
